From the press: T.V.B. part of his subconscious
spiritual life. The dominant motifs here include
all kinds of plant forms, the wheel, the eye, the
sky, the sea and the woman. The characteristic is
that the head is never represented, it becomes a
plant being, organically merged with geometric
and even purely abstract structures and a totally
strange world arises, which fascinates and
seduces through shapes and colors, totally foreign
to nature or the environment.

of this reality sometimes continue to appear in
part, but entirely written in a different alphabet.
