Memorial march for the victims of the Coubre Explosion of March 5, 1960 in Havana. From left to right: Fidel Castro, Osvaldo Dorticós, Che Guevara, Regino Boti, Augusto Martínez, Antonio Núñez, William Alexander Morgan and Eloy Gutiérrez Menoyo. The attack took place on March 4, 1960, in the port of Havana. The French cargo ship, La Courbe, which was carrying Belgian munitions to the revolutionaries, exploded twice. There were around a hundred dead and injured. The attack was blamed by the Cuban government on the United States, which then put pressure on
