This is a batel box from the end of the 19th century, in embossed silver. The very soft metal, the age and use of the box influence the closing of the lid. This magnificent box, which can also be used as a jewelry box or even a sweet box, needs to be cleaned if you want to remove its beautiful patina. There are several, identical to the National Museum of Delhi: Betel box (Pandan) from Mughal Era in India Preserved at National Museum of New Delhi "Comparative Artistic Study & First Published" and I leave it to you to read the article .
