Description

LOUIS XVI period

Pendulum in chiseled and gilded bronze, called
"The return of Love".

The subjects are distributed around the clock
gimbal and rest on an architectural base, centered
on an openwork reserve of a trophy of love.

It rests on a raised entablature in ebony veneer
decorated with openwork bronze interlacing.

Turned feet.

Wire movement, enamel dial with Roman and
Arabic numerals.

Attributed to the bronzier Martincourt.
