This painting was made from a painting by the famous Dutch painter Ferdinand Bol entitled Portrait of a mathematician tracing a geometric figure.

Ferdinand Bol (1616 - 1680) was a Dutch (United Provinces) painter, engraver and draftsman of the Golden Age, 17th century, author of portraits and paintings on biblical subjects. He was one of Rembrandt's best students. The works of Ferdinand Bol belong to the baroque style. He is
