Oval-shaped, pendant decorated on its top with rose-cut diamonds in a black enameled cross pattern. Chiselled decorations of plants and arabesques are enamelled black throughout the jewel. Two rose-cut diamonds are set on either side on openwork gold arabesques which border the pendant. A gold pompom made up of small chains ending in gold pearls and presenting a chiseled and enameled dome cap, is attached like a tassel to a ring decorated in applique with a motif representing a small black enameled and chiseled leaf. A double chain holds the whole thing to a bail. Period: 19th century Main material: yellow gold, 750 thousandths, 18 carats.
