Pityful Christ in oak wood 16th century or also called Christ in Bonds because of its rope on the wrists. Flat back The stylistic study associated with the material of oak wood allows: a) to date it between the beginning and the middle of the 16th century. - short perizonium - well-studied body musculature b) the location either in Flanders or Hispano-Flemish given the influence of Flanders during these periods on Spain and vice versa.
