Terrestrial globe or world map, with sea currents, drawn up by the geographer J.Forest*, 17-19 rue de Buci in Paris, Girard et Barrère Editeurs, scale 1/50,000,000, blackened wooden base, early period mid-20th century. This globe is in good general condition. It is signed on the side. Note: some accidents on the globe, slight dent at the top (see red arrow), cracks and gaps on the globe, some stains and wear from time, see photos (see red arrows). * Joseph Forest (1865-?) is a French geographer and cartographer. In 1886, he founded his publishing house of maps and plans, world maps, globes, terrestrial and celestial spheres, tables and wall maps for teaching at 17-19, rue de Buci in Paris and remains at 1, place du 13 October in Bagneux. Supplier to schools since 1889 and approved by the Ministry of Public
