Damian Garrido: signature used continuously by the artist from 1988 to 2002 in pieces special in terms of size and quality. D.G. Italic, used in pieces on which no larger punch is possible. It should be borne in mind that in silverware the hallmarks are made with a stationary chisel, one end of which has the distinctive mark on the reverse. the mark will appear positive on the surface of the silver object once it is struck quickly and without hesitation by the hammer

Our pieces of silverware are carefully selected for their quality, restored in perfect condition by our silversmiths experts in removal, brightening

Remains the use of time (micro scratches) which is the prerogative of their authenticity.
