Dutch painting representing a charming scene with a light message: "useless resistance", in which we see a man of a certain age making advances towards a younger woman, the latter trying to resist while knocking over a jug of wine, a small dog barking at his feet, the scene taking place under the complacent gaze of a man smoking a pipe.

on the left we see a four-poster bed and on the left a servant arriving through a door from a lit room. a large mirror overlooking the whole. the details are very fine.

condition of the house, the old varnish is slightly yellowed, some small paint losses vertically on the left.

beautiful wooden and gilded stucco frame from the 19th Century.
