



Inkwell Revenge. End Of The 19th Century.



Description

Screwed up*: cylindrical inkwell in transparent and green blown glass, a small chip is visible on the cork (and some photos) which is not the original one. *The term screwed up designates the entire work of glassmakers produced during their leisure time or wasted time; the inkwell revenge is an illustration of the desire of glass workers to demonstrate the great possession of their technique.
