The gilding shows some wear, the whole thing is heavily patinated by time and use, giving this seat a lot of charm. the upholstery is old, it is equipped with a removable cushion in very good condition and very comfortable. The covering fabric is a beautiful velvet decorated with alternating stripes and interlacing floral motifs.
