Very beautiful oil on wood measuring 55cm x 46cm plus modern frame 73cm x 64cm signed lower right Arsène SARI Arsène SARI is one of the great Provençal painters He settled in the Montparnasse district in Paris, where he lived for more than thirty years while working in the Paris metro. At the same time, he pursued a career as a painter and met most of the great artists of the early 20th century. He became friends with Antoine Bourdelle and received advice from Auguste Renoir. In October 1928, he co-founded the Salon of Real Independents where he exhibited until the Second World War. He exhibited in Paris at the Winter Salon from 1937 to 1947. He sometimes returned at length to the South, notably in the post-war years in Marseille,

and resided with his wife in Roquevaire in a former factory in the city between 1964. and 1978. He became the dean of the Péano painters, a community of artists based in the Arcenaulx district of Marseille, including among others Pierre Ambrogiani, Antoine Ferrari, Antoine Gianelli, Jo Berto, René Seyssaud, Auguste Chabaud and Antoine Serra .
