Signed on the lock "Tahan, rue de la Paix 30".
Napoleon III period. H_9.5 cm L_17.5 cm D_14 cm
Luxury production from the Napoleon III period between 1849 and 1866: this box is signed by Maison Tahan rue de la Paix, one of the most prestigious cabinet makers in Paris in the second half of the Nineteenth century. From 1849 to 1866 the Tahan house was located on rue de la Paix in Paris, before moving to boulevard des Italiens. Tahan, cabinetmaker to Emperor Napoleon III, provided the imperial furniture storage. The Court then placed a large number of orders for libraries, tables, pedestal tables and necessary items. The Tahan house was present at
