Bertrand Py (1895-1973) Portrait of a woman with a yellow turban (circa 1940) Oil on canvas mounted on panel 61x50cm signed lower right Bertrand PY was born in 1895 in Belfort. At a very young age, he showed serious inclinations for drawing and painting. Based in Paris, he pursued good classical studies which he stopped abruptly to devote himself exclusively to painting. He entered the National School of Fine Arts by cheating on his age. Frequents galleries, the Louvre Museum and copies the works of Rembrandt, Vermeer, Velasquez, Chardin, Delacroix.
