Good condition. By Daniel Derveaux First half of the 20th century, around 193/40.- Daniel Derveaux, is a French artist and art publisher (1914/2010). His artistic and literary career began in the North, during the 1930s. The young artist then traveled through Ferrain and benefited from the teaching of the Bailleul painter and engraver Jules Alphonse Deturck.
