Ring from the 60s in 750/°° white gold (18 KT, eagle's head hallmark), in band format. A garter of brilliant-cut diamonds in the center is framed by two lines of white gold balls. Each element brings shine while playing on the contrast of materials. A visual equivalence exists here between the dimensions of the diamonds, decreasing, on the principle of the garter, and the golden balls. Each round element is well drawn by contrast on the skin because the ring is openwork which gives it a certain lightness, while the general roundness effect gives this jewel a lot of femininity. The whole thing offers a nice covering volume on the finger.
