This piece of furniture, very imbued with the Empire style and its Hellenistic taste (influence and presence of the ancient Greek world in Egypt between the 4th century BC and the Roman conquest in the 2nd century BC): "antique" pilasters, lotus flowers, cornice carved with palmettes (Anthemion). Taking up the codes of the Louis XVI library, it is made up of two bodies. The lower part has full wooden doors, the upper part is glazed. Our library is a beautiful work from the Louis-Philippe era.
