Slightly convex cap, chiselled with radiating ribs leading to a small rivet knob.

Long shank decorated with water leaves and a small medallion, frieze of twelve scallops.

Brown horn handle.

Finger joint with eyelet near the cap for passing the lanyard.

Shell chased with water leaves and an anchor surmounted by the imperial crown.

Quillon with dolphin head.

Later shell with roped edge.

Bouterolle decorated with water leaves and a scallop shell.
