The coffee table stands out for its tripartite central foot which divides to form three legs in the shape of a feral paw, a detail that gives the piece of furniture an elegant and unique appearance. The mahogany wood used to construct the table is known for its beauty and durability. It has a warm, rich hue that pairs perfectly with the overall design of the piece. Above the central foot, we find an octagonal top made of white marble, which gives the table a touch of elegance. The tabletop also offers a durable and hard-wearing surface, ideal for
