Beautiful box in grained black morocco and iron fittings. Mounted on four ball feet, it opens with a slightly domed lid. Beautiful trim of five frets holding the five hinges and ending with a fleur-de-lys finial, cut iron spandrels at the corners, stirrup handle and keyhole with two bent hasps on plate forming a heart. Old key and functional lock. The interior is lined with original white paper. Very good general condition..
