## Description

Beautiful Flemish painting, made in oil on panel, which depicts an elegant gentleman dressed in elegant clothes of the time, including the typical collar. The realization of the details and the realism with which the portrait is painted are surprising, with particular attention dedicated to the gaze which almost seems to dialogue with the viewer. The artist of this work fits perfectly into Michiel Jansz Van Mierevelt's school of Flemish painting from the second half of the 17th century, highlighting a clear link with that artistic tradition. The painting is framed in an elegant wooden frame gilded with pure gold leaf, which further enhances the beauty and importance of the work.
