Beautiful 19th century box, for jewelry or others, with gilded brass structure and walls made of thick beveled glass panels. Very beautiful rare object in these dimensions and in very good condition; it rests on four arched bronze legs decorated with foliage centered with radiating medallions in the style of corollas of flowers.* Alphonse Giroux, or in the same vein. *Each glass panel is set with a multitude of small claws which take the approximate shape of fleur-de-lis. The thick glass panels with wide bevels overflow the thickness of the structure and offer a beautiful visual effect with beautiful reflections. The cover of the lid, also in bronze, forms arcatures and takes up the motifs of floral corollas echoing the decoration of the base; the background is covered in black fabric (For
