Jean Bulio was born in Fabrègues in Hérault on December 1, 1827. He left for Paris where he became a student of Armand Toussaint then he entered the École des beaux-arts on October 10, 1851. He debuted at the Salon of 1859 with a plaster Pandora. Honorable mention in 1882 and 1886. He exhibited for the last time in 1903 then
