Description

This remarkable statue of the Triumph of Neptune, made in Italian ceramic at the end of the 19th century, illustrates the grandeur and power of the god of the seas. In this representation, Neptune is standing, firmly holding his trident, while he is carried above the waves by two pegasi and two dolphins, symbolizing his domination over the marine elements. The scene is completed by the presence of a triton blowing a conch, adding a touch of dynamism and life to the composition. This sculptural group, initially designed as an integral part of a tabletop, demonstrates the artistic refinement and fascination with mythology that prevailed at the time. With dimensions of 50x30x30 cm, this statue impresses with its imposing size and striking presence. Despite its age, it remains in
