Ovoid in shape with a body resting on a slight heel. Large weir cut into a brace above the slightly flattened cove. HARD porcelain White background decorated with garlands of foliage and branches. Wolf teeth and gold fillets on the edges. Gilding highlights on the handle

Dimension(s): Height. 6" - Length. 12.9 cm

Mark(s): Painted in grand feu blue at "MOULIN".

This brand corresponds to the 1st period of the Manufacture. Condition: PARFIAT

CONDITION Period: LATE LOUIS XV - Ep. 18th

Observation(s): Small wear from use.

Finding CLIGNANCOURT porcelain pieces bearing the "MOULIN" mark is extremely rare. Only a few rare pieces are known to date. Most of the pieces are generally decorated in gold monochrome. Few polychrome pieces are listed.
