This amusing netsuke depicts a sambaso dancer, standing upright wearing a loose-fitting robe, and a characteristic tall-pointed eboshi headdress, carrying an open fan in his right hand and suzu bells in the other. The details are picked out in shades of overglaze brown and blue. The tongue and the head are movable, with two symmetrical himotoshi at the backside. This is rare example as it is a human form and not a monkey which is ususally depicted in these netsuke.
