Description

Small clock in working order, in gilded bronze in Louis XVI style, from the 19th century. The decoration of the clock takes on the attributes of the Louis XVI style. A beaded oval medallion surrounds two kissing birds, symbolizing Spring in Love. The medallion is held by a garland of flowers joining the sides of the clock.

The central enameled dial is marked "HOPILLIART" and located at "12 rue des Saints-Pères Paris".

The bezel protecting the dial is made of beveled glass. Note 2 small accidents on the periphery of the glass on its internal side (see photo). The clock is surmounted by a vase on a pedestal with ram's heads.
