Description

This elegant pendulum table clock in gilded and burnished bronze represents a tribute to the magnificence of Napoleon Buonaparte. The upper part actually features the bust of the emperor in white porcelain, while the wire suspension mechanism ensures precise operation. The porcelain dial is supported and enriched by four crouching lions, a symbol of royalty. The base is decorated with frames worked in gilded bronze, with the image of Vulcan on the front, the God of fire who builds the war axe, in honor of Napoleon's war exploits. This watch is of French manufacture, with the mark of the famous Sèvres manufacture from the first half of the 19th century on the back. A unique piece that combines the elegance of the design with the history and greatness of the French emperor.
