Pencil and watercolor drawing in the style of a miniature representing the portrait of Charles Morin (1846-1919) attributed to the painter Marie Von Parmentier (1846-1879).

Framed in gilded wood and blue and gold mat. Period around 1870.

Charles Camille Morin (1846 - 1919)

French painter in the wake of the Barbizon school, he painted landscapes of Ile-de-France, Brittany and the South. He exhibited at the Salon des Artistes français from 1889 to 1898, he became a member in 1897. From 1888 to 1890, he published chronicles and reports in the Journal

des Artistes, some under the signature of Camille
