- Ewer or coffee pot- Sterling silver and ebony handle- By Abel Etienne Giroux, master goldsmith in Paris from 1798 to 1815- Paris, 1798-1809- Height (at the grip): 35 cm, 34 cm (at the grip) ; weight (gross): 1045g- Very good condition, beautiful and fresh carving- Tripod ewer with ovoid body, mounted on three beveled feet with lion's paws and ribbed attachments in acanthus branches. The moving lid has an oak acorn grip on a terrace of leaves.- Hallmarks (in the lid, under the body) : master goldsmith: AEG with a panache for Abel-Etienne Giroux [Dict, n°144, Nocq T.II]; Title: vertical octagon, an erect rooster holed to the right and the number 1 at the bottom right, for the 1st title of 950 thousandths, Paris, 1798-1809; Guarantee: Head of a man facing the number 85, medium
