Description

Evocative oil painting on canvas, attributed to the famous painter Jan Miel, also known as Giovannino delle Vite, active in the 17th century (Beveren-Waas 1599 - Turin 1663). The scene depicted is an enchanting rural landscape, animated by female figures, children and a traveller. The latter is portrayed riding a donkey drinking from a fountain. On the right side of the painting, a mother with two children attracts attention, surrounded by other figures that populate the painting. The work is characterized by a masterful use of chiaroscuro, which gives depth and three-dimensionality to the composition. The detail and attention to detail are evident in every corner of the painting, making the scene alive and engaging for the viewer. The painting is framed in a carved and gilded wooden
