He often painted rural scenes, scenic views of nature, and picturesque environments, using techniques that made his works both realistic and evocative. His paintings were appreciated for their tranquil atmosphere and their ability to capture the very essence of the countryside. His artistic style was influenced by the Romantic and Realist movements of the time,
