Jean-Michel Gustave Anglade, a 19th century American landscape painter. Born in France in 1827, he emigrated to the United States, it is not known when, and became famous for his landscape paintings that captured the natural beauty of rural areas and pastoral scenes. Anglade was known for his ability to vividly depict landscapes with careful attention to detail and light. He often painted rural scenes, scenic views of nature, and picturesque environments, using techniques that made his works both realistic and evocative. His paintings were appreciated for their tranquil atmosphere and their ability to
