Manufacture of Creil, period of the Legros Stone Coquerel patent, fine earthenware plate with printed decoration representing the portrait of the Empress Joséphine le marlis decorated with oak leaves in used condition, striped in the decoration Diameter 21cm Work circa 1808-1818 bibio The Manufacture de Creil founded in 1797 will produce from 1808 to 1818 printed earthenware under the patent filed by Legros d'Anizy and his associates Stone and Coquerel, the only ones authorized in France at that time to produce printed decorations, in the workshops on rue du dial in Paris
