Svend Aage Holm Sørensen (1913-2004) was a Danish industrial designer and architect trained at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen, who made a significant contribution to the development of modernist design in Denmark.

Holm Sørensen's designs were characterized by their simplicity, elegance and functionality, and he was particularly known for his work in lighting design. He was a true master of modernist design and his work was characterized by his experimental approach to materials and forms.
