(engineer) will help his brother Henri to create
electric clocks: the Brillié Frères workshops are
born. They are not the first to build an electric

clock but will enable its democratization thanks to remote synchronization. The principle is simple, a master clock made it possible to send an electrical pulse. This guaranteed perfect synchronization and avoided the loss of time associated with winding clocks. Whether in France or abroad, many factories, stations, schools, etc. will thus be equipped with this very innovative system. The Brillié company experienced a strong period of growth in the 1960s and 1970s and became the overwhelming leader in industrial watchmaking in France. However, the company will have difficulty adapting to technological developments and Asian competition in the 1980s and will cease its activity in 1987.
