The mirror Louis XVI under examination, of clear Piedmontese manufacture, was made of carved and gilded wood and has on top a perforated cymatium decorated with scroll friezes.

The Louis XVI style of furniture precedes by a few years the reign of Louis XVI (1774-1793), from which it takes its name, and is characterized

by the renunciation of domed and extroverted forms, in favor of a straight, simpler, sober and geometric line, inspired by Greek-Classicismroman.

Even today, Louis XVI furniture is synonymous with elegance and prestige. The furnishings that date back to this era follow, therefore, a simple taste but at the same time elegant and refined, and are cared for in detail with extreme precision, as we can see in this mirror. The technical perfection of their execution is so high as to make it almost impossible to create copies, so it is very rare that frames and furniture in Louis XVI style are falsified.

The Louis XVI style was considered the golden age of French furniture, where demand from the aristocracy was high and frequent.
