The general quality of manufacturing of these earrings can also be seen on their back, openwork in honeycomb, and the attention to detail in the shape of the rackets, fitted with a pellet giving a good grip for their handling. The closure system is therefore exclusively made up of clips (suitable for pierced and non-pierced ears).
