The unknown artist depicts the story of Joseph and his brothers. In Genesis, Joseph is the last of 12 brothers, all jealous of him because he is their father's favorite.

He will be sold into slavery by his last. The story of Joseph still remains incredible and mysterious today. But the episode of the well, which is represented here, is very well known.

The eldest, Reuben, does not want Joseph to be killed. Instead, he will be stripped and thrown at the bottom of a well.
