A talented portraitist, Girardet is Stanislas's official painter Leszczynski whom he immortalized in his paintings as well as those of the people of the court and the artists and the nobility of Lorraine and Barroise1. He also excelled in large decorative paintings such as religious paintings. His works adorn the Saint-Étienne cathedral in Toul, the churches of Lunéville, Chanteheux, Commercy, Verdun and Metz.
