for sculpture , from an early age , led him to devote himself entirely to the study of form and material .His works show a very high degree of detail, execution and finish . He models his figures in wax or clay , then casts them in bronze using lost wax or sand . Orientalist figures are also among his subjects . O. Ruffony , enjoyed a reputation acquired during his lifetime , and still real , thanks to his identifiable sculptures .He made a name for himself on the art scene of his time , appreciated by the public and art lovers alike .
