Magnificent Louis XVI period chest of drawers in mahogany and mahogany veneer. Very elegant model with three rows of drawers, opening in the lower part with two large drawers and 3 smaller ones. Front base in fluted columns with projection as well as the rear base with projection too. For damping, brass scrapers. The whole is surrounded by brass moldings. The white Carrara marble top is bordered by an openwork brass gallery. Original trefoil key handles and locks (one key for all 5 drawers). The drawers are made of oak wood, a removable white fabric covering has been made so as not to stain the things you store there. We are in the presence of a very beautiful piece of furniture from the Louis XVI period which, although not stamped, is of very high quality. Louis XVI period, late 18th century.
