Antonin Ponchon (Terrenoire 1891-Celle-sur-Seine 1965) "Cancale" (Brittany) 1951, oil on canvas, 54 x 65 cm (with frame 69 x 79.5 cm) Antonin Ponchon was a student at the Beaux-Arts in Lyon as well than at the Lyon Conservatory of Dramatic Art. A founding member of the Ziniar group in 1920 and of the Salon du Sud-Est in 1925, he founded with the art critic Marius Mermillon the Galerie des Archers which welcomed the great names of French painting.
