Made with precious materials such as the chalky background and rice paper, it is decorated with scenes painted on a graffitied gold background and polychromes in rich red tones. The Chinese landscape representations featured on the furniture include traditional houses, boats and human figures. The structure of the furniture is made up of three bodies, with a sliding opening top and side drawers, as well as small compartments for objects. The elegant turned legs are enriched with golden details, giving the furniture a refined and classy appearance. This unique piece is able to add a touch of oriental exoticism to the furnishings, making the environment fascinating
