It represents a Columbine in love with a Pierrot performing the symbol of the female sex with his hands, in the light of the moon.

Louis Morin (1855-1938), French painter, caricaturist and author. After studying with his father, he studied sculpture, architecture and drawing. Founder of the Society of Cartoonists and author of a Monograph on Cartooning, he also created wall decorations, notably the dome of the Printemps store (now destroyed).
