Description

Two-tone half-creole earrings in 750/°° yellow and white gold (18 KT, owl hallmark). With an 80s aesthetic, they are large and their general triangular shape is created by the juxtaposition of asymmetrical panels, openworked between them, the yellow ones in all gold, and the white ones paved with brilliant-cut diamond grains. These asymmetrical sections give a very dynamic aesthetic to these otherwise classic earrings, to which the diamonds add a jewelry touch. Their closure system consists of a rod (for pierced ears) combined with a clip for better support. If you do not have pierced ears, our workshop can easily remove the stem for wearing with clips for non-pierced ears. Conversely, it will also be possible for us to remove the clip system...alpas systems are already offered as a complement.
