Early 19th century silver cutlery in the net model with the alliance coats of arms of the Protestant families Mallet and Oberkampf under a baron's crown with a motto "recte et vigilenter" (Righteousness and vigilance) which is that of the Oberkampf.

They were created for Jules Mallet (189-1866) who married Emilie Oberkampf (1794 - 1856) in 1812.

Composition of the cutlery:

9 forks with hallmark on the 2nd cock
(1808-1819)

2 forks from the 18th century

11 spoons with hallmark on the 2nd rooster
(1808-1819)

Silversmith : Jean Joseph Rivet received in 1815
