### Description

Vase with two handles in polychrome iridescent enameled earthenware decorated with storks.

Signed "J. BAROL" at the base. From the Art-Nouveau period around 1900. All in good state of conservation. After starting with Clément Massier, Jean Barol joined forces in the BACS workshop (Barol, Alexandre, Carle, Sicard), Barol is the B of BACS. He left for Montières-les Amiens where he revived the production of earthenware. Returning to Cannes-la-Bocca in 1920, he continued his personal work of colored spots, metallic lusters on tense and nervous curves.
