They are a pair of oils on oak panels from the end of the 18th century in the style of the Northern school.

These Flemish paintings are inspired by the Flemish schools of the high period, the spirit is quite close.

we see two hermit monks in scenes from their daily life with a meal scene and another reading scene. we find the two identical characters in their cave with a Christ at their side and a skull reminiscent of the vanities and memento moris.
